This CIT Academy is a forty-hour course of instruction that is completed in a one-week session.

The objectives of the CIT Academy are to:

- Increase officers' awareness of behavioral health issues and empathy of individuals experiencing behavioral health disorders.
  - Instruct officers in effective techniques utilized when encountering individuals experiencing behavioral health issues and provide safer interventions.
    - Broaden officers' knowledge of resources and understanding of legal issues.
    - Assist officers with understanding how to provide the most appropriate resolutions.

## Peace Officers who successfully complete this training and pass all required testing will be recognized by the State of Utah as a CIT Officer.

Non peace officers that successfully complete this training will receive a certificate of completion. Due to some physical aspects of this academy, peace officers on light duty will not be allowed to attend.
